We really need to think further ahead about technology opportunities, risks and the consequences of failing to take action, whether it be missing out on huge opportunities, loss of competitive advantage, or lack of planning for the impact of automation."

Joining Evans in addressing conference attendees will be opening keynote presenter, TED speaker and best-seller author – and former graffiti artist – Erik Wahl on the discipline of creativity and turning ideas into action.

IT audit, risk, cybersecurity and governance professionals will gather at the Hilton Chicago to examine fast-evolving trends, technologies and career strategies – and earn up to 39 continuing professional education (CPE) hours.
